

MAUMEE CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES  
Tuesday, January 13, 2026 at 4 pm

The Council of the City of Maumee, Ohio met on the above date in Council Chambers with the following members present: Rosemarie Barciz, Gabriel Barrow, Isiah Gonzalez, Andrew Huyghe, Ted Kurt, Dave Poeppelmeier, and Scott Sund (7). Chelsea Ziss presiding.

Mr. Barrow moved to approve Ordinance 002-2026, an ordinance reestablishing Chapter 177 of the Maumee Codified Ordinances and reestablishing a Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission. Mr. Poeppelmeier seconded the motion. Roll call: 7 voted yea, the Chair declared the motion carried.
