CONSENT CALENDAR:

A. City council has examined each item on the consent calendar, proposed legislation and other items set forth on this agenda that involves the expenditure of public funds, use of public property or use of City of Maumee resources and have determined and find that any action or expenditure set forth in those items, would be for and serve a public purpose as defined by Ohio law; that the expenditure and/or use of public property would be for the general good of the residents and taxpayers of the City of Maumee and the general public; and promotes the public health and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Maumee and the general public.

B. Recommendation from City Administrator:

Authorize and grant a permit for soliciting the annual charity paper sale for the Toledo Old Newsboys Goodfellows Association, on Friday, December 6, 2024, from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. The sale will occur at the corner of the Anthony Wayne Trail and Conant Street.

C. Recommendation from the Law Director:

Authorizing the City Administrator and Service Department to establish programs for the purpose of conducting inspections to determine if there are connections to the Maumee sanitary sewer system and inspecting sanitary sewer laterals and not assess fee for said inspections as these inspections, that involve expenditure of public funds or use of City property or city employees, or use of City of Maumee resources in resolving nuisance conditions, would be for and serve a public purpose as defined by Ohio law; that the expenditure of funds and/or use of public property and/or provision of city employees would be for the general good of the residents and taxpayers of the City of Maumee and the general public; and promotes the public health and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Maumee and the general public.
