**A. Recommendation from Law Director:**

Authorize the Mayor to enter into the CHIP 2025-2027 Agreement between Lucas County, Maumee and Oregon.

**B. Recommendation from Mayor:**

Authorize the Mayor to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with The Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments (TMACOG-now Lake Erie West Regional Council) to commit to pay \$869.08 towards the 2026 Lake Erie Starts Here Northwest Ohio Campaign, to being a dues paying member of TMACOG, and to remain current of Stormwater Coalition assessment payments.
